### Artisans



### A Reminder . . . The Gals are Coming! Giant African Land Snail

Our guest speaker for our first meeting is Paula R. Dwyer, who is an information specialist for the plant industry, a division of the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The plant industry is currently running the Eradication program in Pasco County of the giant African land snail. She will speak on how did this invasive species arrive in Florida, their habitat, and why they need to be eradicated. There will be time for questions after her presentation. I, personally would like to have one of those snails in my shell collection. Maybe, we can inquire about that!





### About our Speaker . . .

Paula Dwyer is the Public Information Officer (PIO) for Southern Florida for the Division of Plant Industry (DPI), Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS). Paula's PIO duties take her across Florida, giving presentations and informing the public about DPI's mission to protect Florida's native and commercially grown plants and the state's beekeeping industry from harmful pests and diseases. She also works on emergency programs to eradicate invasive pests, such as the Great African Land Snail (GALS), which is currently going on in Pasco County.

Originally from Southern California, Paula has lived in a number of locations, including Indiana, New York and Scotland. Her background includes diverse jobs in journalism, education, training and customer service. Paula is married to Tim, with two sons, Peter and Philip, and shares a home with a large red dog named Gus.



- VII. New Business: None at this time.


### VIII. Door Prizes:

The Club archives do not have minutes of a September, 1972 meeting


### 25 Years Ago
